2 Hawks Nest Miners Camp

Gold was discovered in the Ravensthorpe district in 1898.

The Annabel Gold Mine 1901 - Worked by Bob Stevenson and Harry.

3 Ravensthorpe School 1901 - The school opened in Ravensthorpe in 1901.

Mechanics Institute 1907 - Range View Park now occupies this site.

4 Site of the Phillips River Times newspaper office

These premises burnt down in 1911

- 5 Site of the original Phillips River Road Board
- 6 Dance Cottage 1900 George Dance was a successful entrepreneur.
- 7 Site of the Ravensthorpe Hotel

The first hotel to be built in the town 1901-1924

- 8 Lansell's General Store 1901 He also had stores in Desmond and Kundip.
- 9 Site of FE Daw & Sons General Store

(formerly Legges Clothing & Chemist, 1900)

- **10** Carlisle Chambers The premises were demolished in 2012
- 11 Site of the premises of Dan and Patrick Coleman

The Coleman brothers married two Aboriginal sisters.

12 Site of original gaol and police residence, 1901 - The first gaol was a tent.

Warden FW Spence's house, 1906

- **13 Commercial Hotel, 1906** The first two storey building in town.
- **14 Post Office 1901 -** The original building burnt down in 2017.

Hakea Victoria sculpture – a community project.

- **15** Wardens Court Warden Spence arrived in 1900.
 - **Assay Office** Charles Grant was a well-respected Mine Manager.
- **16 Dunn Brothers General Store, 1901 -** The first white settlers to the district.
 - Miners Arms Built by the Dunn family in 1901.
- **17 WA Bank** One of the first brick buildings in the town.
- **18** The Palace Hotel 1907 Built in 1900 later replaced by the Palace Hotel.
- **19** Ambulance Shed 1955 CWA Rooms Initially the St John Ambulance Shed in 1955.
- **20 St Andrews Church 1907** The he only corrugated iron church still in use in WA.
- **21** The site of the first CBH bulk handling grain bins Now occupied by the Ravensthorpe Town Hall.
- **22 Site of the house built by the Dunn family** The first white settlers in the district.
 - **The Union Bank 1907 -** Across the road is the site of the Union Bank.
- 23 Edmunds house, 1907 Daniel Edmunds was an architect.
- 24 The Daw House, 1905 Built by store owner FE Daw.
 - The First Daws Store Francis E Daw ran a general store on this site.
- **Chapmans Boarding House** Charles Chapman built the first Ravensthorpe Hospital in 1904, at a cost of \$92.
